Please take the time to review the enlosed information. You'll find everything you need to know; from what your child will be eating for snack each day to what they'll be learning in Big Group. DROP OFF AND PICK UP

When campers arrive on Monday morning, they can proceed directly to their group square. Not sure what that means? Don't panic. Each camper will be placed in a group that has a number. Group numbers will be posted on the KidsGames App by no later than Sunday, June 26, and will also be posted on campus on the first day of camp. When you arrive on campus, just look for that group number's square, marked by their large numbered flag or sign. This is where you'll be dropping off and picking up your camper every day of camp.

Our KidsGames Junior group squares are in the BCC Youth Warehouse. Our 1st- 5th KidsGames group squares are in the BCC auditorium.

Every child must be walked onto campus on the first day of KidsGames by a responsible party over 18 years old. Tuesday through Friday, our camper "drive-through" lane for 1st - 5th grade campers will be available on the east side of the building, closest to the strip mall. Please enter off of Hamilton Ave on the west side of the building, then follow the drive through line behind our main building. We will have volunteers ready to greet them and help them get to their headquarters with their guides. Gates for the drive through lane will be opened 15 minutes prior to pick up and will be closed 15 minutes after the start of camp. Please note, the drive through lane is only available for drop off ONLY.


NEW THIS YEAR: All age groups will be utilizing a wristband system. On Monday morning, your camper will be given a wristband with a printed code on it. You'll be given a matching wristband withe same code. In order to enter the building at pick up each day, you'll need to show your wristband (Don't worry--you don't need to wear it! As long as you have it in your possession, you'll be allowed in). To leave the building with your camper, you'll need to display your matching wristband to one of our volunteers at the door. A photo of your wristband is also acceptable.

Campers will be asked to wear their same wristband all week long. Should your camper need a replacement wristband during the week, please visit our Guest Services tent.

Any campers who are not picked up within 10 minutes of the end of each session will be taken to the Guest Services tent for late pickup.

PARKING

There is very limited parking on the Beachcities campus during the week of KidsGames. Parent parking is available along Hamilton Avenue or also in the Beachcities overflow parking lot on Brookhurst Ave, adjacent to the Arco station. We realize that our drop-off/pick-up and parking situations are less than ideal. Thank you for your understanding and patience in regard to the challenges presented by our present location.



CAMP SHIRTS

Camp shirts are available for pre-camp pick up here at Beachcities Community Church at the following times:

Saturdays (June 11, 18, 25), 5:00 -6:30PM Sundays (June 12, 19, 26), 8:00 - 11:30AM

The camper shirt pick up table will be located on the patio directly in front of the main building.

If you are not able to pick up your child's camp shirt prior to camp, it will be given to them when they arrive at camp on Monday morning.

ELECTIVES

One way you can help your child enjoy their camp experience is to set proper expectations for their elective time. Our Kidsgames Junior campers will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of electives and activities throughout the week that have already been scheduled for them. Our 1st-5th campers will participate in one elective, selected when you registered them for camp. All campers will find out which specific group number they've been placed in on June 26 through the KidsGames App, or when they arrive on the first day of camp.

SNACK

Each day, our KidsGames team will provide your child with a healthy snack. KidsGames is committed to being a peanut-free zone. If your child has any other significant allergies or dietary restrictions that would necessitate a snack other than the one provided (a daily list is included in this packet), we welcome you to provide an alternative snack for them. This snack can be given to their guide to hold until snack time. If you have any additional questions or concerns, please email kidsgames@beachcities.org.

Please have your child bring a full, re-usable water bottle (marked with their name) to camp with them each day. They will have the opportunity to safely refill it as needed throughout the day.
